

## Special Olympic Letter Jacket Process and Policy

### Special Olympics Letter Jacket Process

- o Athlete must participate in two Special Olympic sports their sophomore year before receiving a jacket.
- o Athletes are measured for a jacket the same time other students are measured for a letter jacket.
- o Athlete will not be eligible for a jacket any earlier than the end of their sophomore year.
- o The District covers the cost of the letter jacket for eligible students.
- o Parents are responsible to pay for patches and cost to put patches on the letter jacket.
- o Athletes may only receive one letter jacket, but they may receive multiple patches for various events.
- o Complete a materials request form to Melissa Mitchell prior to fittings
- o The Special Olympics fundraiser account will be used to pay for letter jackets (865)
